To maximize your results, spray the first application of 0.67 L/ac. between cotyledon and two leaf stage. This sets your crop up for the best start possible and helps it achieve its maximum yield potential. If another treatment is required, you have the flexibility to apply another application of 0.67 L/ac. up to first flower. If spring weather doesn't cooperate or you experience delays, use one application of 1.33 L/ac. up to six leaf stage.
